

# 2006 Rate Schedule Implementations



- It is expected that changes will be made to distributors and transmitters rate schedules for 2006.
- OEB approved changes that may affect settlements are:
  - TLF (DLF or SFLF)
  - Transmission rate schedules
- Concern is that new rate schedules get approved for 2006 with insufficient time for the IESO to respond.
- A new TLF for example will require that any and all totalization tables that contains the changed TLF must be updated. The formal procedure will have to be followed including MSP submission and signed-off SRR.
- Should the new rate schedule be backdated, this may require a post-final adjustment.

# 2006 Rate Schedule Implementations (cont)



- Where the approved rate schedule contains a modification to the present settlement structure - say the definition of embedded is changed - it may take a significant amount of time before the updated tables are signed off.
- Should a large number of changes be approved simultaneously, the IESO will be unable to make the settlement changes in a timely manner.
- It would help all parties if the IESO could build the tables ahead of time (with a later effective date).
- It is possible some new rates may require an Engineering calculation for example – this may take time.
- Even if the best information turned out to be wrong for some of the tables, it would still be advantageous.
